SUMMARY: This presentation was designed to explain the rules relating to air travel under the Convention for Unification of Certain Rules Relating to International Carriage by Air, commonly referred to in the industry as The Warsaw Convention and the Montreal Convention, which is designed to modernize and consolidate the Warsaw Convention and related instruments.
